623 RUNNYMEDE POLICING UPDATE

The Committee noted the latest updates on policing in Runnymede which had been provided by Inspector Pinkerton, the Borough Inspector.

In recent meetings, the Crime and Disorder Committee had received regular policing updates from Surrey Police. The meeting of the Crime and Disorder Committee scheduled for 7 February 2018 had been cancelled as a result of the volume of business for the Overview and Scrutiny Select Committee on that same evening.
