NOTICE OF MOTION UNDER STANDING ORDER 15 FROM COUNCILLOR J R FUREY

Motion will be considered immediately after Agenda Item 7 on the Council Summons (Petitions)

Further to SO 15.6 (ii), The Motion to be moved by Councillor JR Furey : -

“This Council expresses it’s disapproval of the decision of Lloyds Bank to close its Addlestone branch, which is due to be implemented within the next few weeks.

Despite public statements by Lloyds Bank that it had consulted with elected Members, local residents and local business; no such consultation took place which is deeply regrettable.

The Council wishes to express its support for local residents and businesses, who wish to access their banking services at a local branch rather than remotely.

The Council invites the Leader of the Council to contact the board of Lloyds Bank to invite them to agree to delay the proposed closure of its Addlestone Branch so that it may enter into an immediate and meaningful consultation with elected members and our local residents and businesses.”

(Under Standing Order 15.6 (b) (ii), Councillor JR Furey has asked for this Motion to be determined at this meeting as the matter is exceptionally urgent. The Mayor has so agreed.)
