Feedback

The purpose of informing residents and consulting was to give residents the opportunity to express their views, on what we assumed would have a negative impact. We received **25** emails from residents to our dedicated Listening inbox, and **6** people came to talk to us at the consultation events.

Comments consisted of:

- Increase security at garage sites
- Lack of alternative parking
- Lack of alternative storage facilities available
- The terms of the garage tenancy agreement and the clause regarding storage
- Concerns of safety and anti-social behaviour
- Residents were keen for us to consider the redevelopments that would meet existing needs, such as storage units and parking.
